Today, at 10 AM (Saturday, July 12), two current Wilson HS students, Hanna Mahon and Sarah Cox-Schrader, will **testify in song** before the DC Council Committee of the Whole's Public Oversight Hearing on "Youth Issues" in support of the Wilson community-wide effort to restore Dr. Arthur Siebens to his teaching assignment at Wilson HS. He has successfully taught Human Anatomy & Physiology, Botany, and AP Biology for 18 years until recently terminated by the Chancellor's designee in charge of the Wilson HS restructuring process without being given a reason why.

A number of other current and former Wilson HS students are expected to testify as well.
